A few days before Tommy's departure, David Mills, the other missionary couple we are joining at J Lodge, underwent brain treatment to address hand tremors. Although he was expected to return to daily life immediately after the treatment, the side effects of the surgery were more severe than the doctor anticipated, leaving significant paralysis on the left side of his body.



This sudden event has become a great trial for J Lodge Cafe. David's wife, Yuka, has been visiting the hospital to support him. Immediately upon his arrival, Tommy has been supporting the management of J Lodge. We are thankful for God's mercy that allowed Tommy to arrive in Japan in time for this critical moment.
